

HIY&GC By-Law Changes

Article III Government

New Section

Section E-Guests: All members in good standing regardless of their classification are permitted to bring guests to any club or member sponsored events. This includes Golf Tournaments and Social activities.

Item I – Island Guests (Lot Owners) are permitted a maximum of 2 Social Events and must be accompanied by a Member. The exception to this rule is the Friday popcorn social.

Item II – non-Island Guests (no Lot ownership) are not restricted to the number of events they may attend when accompanied by a Member.

Article V Officers, Titles and Duties

Current Version

Section F-Control of Affairs: *The Board of Directors shall have the active business management and control of the affairs and funds of the Club. No Monies in excess of \$75.00 will be spent at any one time, with a favorable vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors.*

New Version

Section F-Control of Affairs: The Board of Directors shall have the active business management and control of the affairs and funds of the Club. Each Board Member is authorized to spend up to \$500.00 at any one time for expenses required to perform their duties as outlined in Article V. Any expenditure outside a Board Members defined duties must have an approval from the responsible Board Member. Any expenditure above \$500.00 must be approved by a favorable vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors.

Article III Government

New Section

Section F – Board of Directors Voting Guidelines: In accordance with a Board of Directors assigned duties the officer may request an electronic vote to approve expenditures outside the limit set in Article V section F. A vote can be conducted via email or phone and must be facilitated by the Commodore. An email and Hatter notice must be issued to the membership with ample time allowed for a response. Email notices only will be considered adequate if 20% of the membership is accessible via this media.
